
Where Moms can enjoy a special evening with their sons

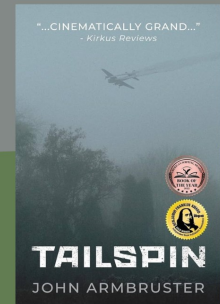
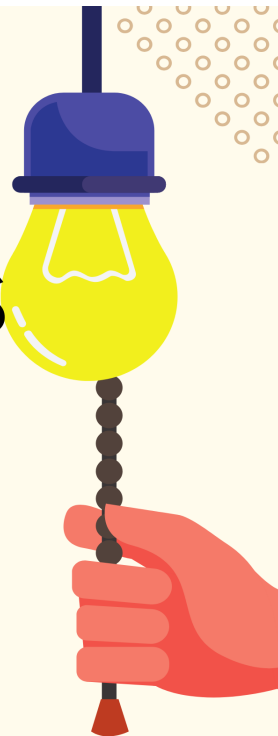
