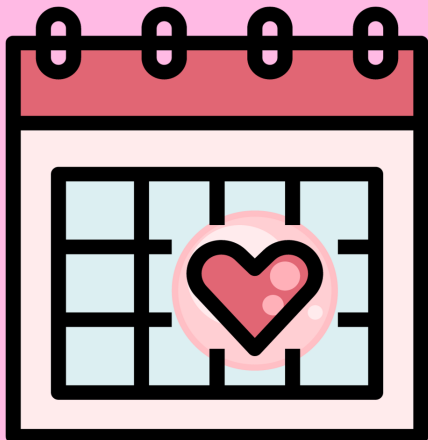

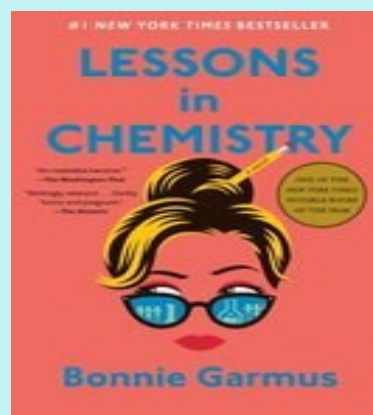

The **Evening Book Club** is reading *Lessons in Chemistry* by Bonnie Garmus. We have copies available at the desk.

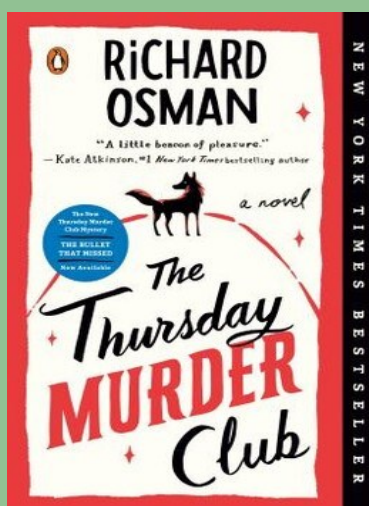
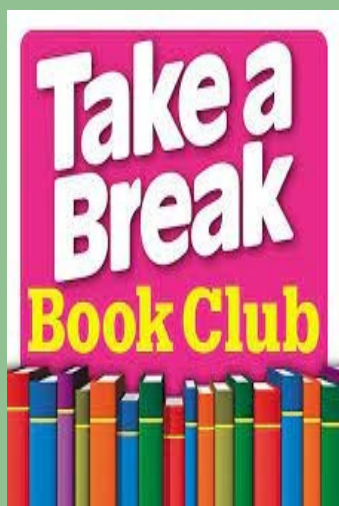
